From the Director of Education

Did you know that when a child begins Kindergarten he or she is assessed on many developmental areas – not just letter and number recognition? A child who is ready for Kindergarten will be able to demonstrate cooperation, positive peer interactions, independence in self-help skills, an ability to communicate thoughts and ideas, impulse control and an ability to follow directions. The KRK curriculum meets all the academic and developmental domains for children to have a well-rounded educational opportunity while enrolled here – from infancy through our Pre-K classrooms!

Each September teachers start the Core Curriculum of Kids 'R' Kids Learning Academy. This is a universal time for starting a new school year; and we take this opportunity to review the basics. We "Welcome" the new year with themes and activities that focus on establishing and revisiting rules, expectations and routines for the classrooms: washing hands, taking care of our belongings, keeping the classrooms clean and how to talk with friends when there is a conflict. Each age level reinforces these concepts with stories, songs, art, and role-modeling. Use of our Brain Waves curriculum assists in building impulse control, following directions and critical thinking skills. Our STEAM curriculum enhances learning with opportunities for students to be hands on learners – experimenting and exploring materials, building "cause and effect" experiences and discussing what has been observed. Show and Tell builds communication skills. Teachers guide the Show and Tell experience through modeling and supporting verbal skills. For Suites 350 through 600 Half Day classes, ABCmouse.com is another way we support learning. With our partnership with ABCmouse.com, our curriculum has been loaded within the program so activities are reinforcing the concepts being taught each week!

How can you support your child's academic success at the early childhood level? Play games in the car for verbal exchanges. READ, READ, READ to your child or even encourage your child to "read" to you by telling a story from the pictures in a book. Use bath time for learning experiences, too. Foam letters and numbers, bath crayons, or even shaving cream that children can use to draw or write while in the tub are great ways to make learning fun and reinforcing what's being taught at school!!
